To be considered for the Joey M. Spano, Varsity 'S' Club Fellowship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a MSU Varsity Letter Winner
- Be a member of the Varsity 'S' Club
- Graduating in 2019-20 or have previously graduated from MSU with an overall GPA of 3.10 or higher
- Have been accepted or pending acceptance into a graduate program at Michigan State University

**NOTE: The MSU Law School is considered a separate entity and is not eligible to receive money from this award. All other post graduate programs are eligible, including the MSU Medical Schools and MSU Veterinarian School.*

The Fellowship will be based on academic success and Michigan State University volunteerism and/or community involvement and service. This scholarship is **not** based on financial need or athletic accomplishments.

Fellowships will be announced in late May 2020 and will be awarded for the Fall semester of 2020 – 2021 academic year. At this time, one \$1,500 (minimum) fellowship for the 2020 – 2021 academic year will be awarded. This is a non-renewable fellowship. You must reapply each year.

If you are awarded the fellowship, you may choose to apply the funds in one of three ways, 1) \$1500 in the fall, or 2) split it as \$750 in the fall and \$750 in the spring or 3) \$1500 in the Spring.
